### **Continuous Improvement and School Vision**

- Regular bi-weekly ILT and SEL team meetings on Tuesdays from 3-4:30 p.m. Current focus of ILT- Vertical Mapping; SEL – evaluation of PBIS. ILT group (CIWP Strategy 1 and 3)
- Meeting with Leader In Me PD team to discuss school readiness for SEL support

### **Professional Learning Systems**

- Reviews weekly lesson plans and provides feedback to teachers.
- Teacher attended PD on Google Classroom and implementation of PLTW STEM curriculum – (CIWP Strategy 1)
- Middle school viewing of Bully. Small group discussions led by teachers and students following the movie.(CIWP Strategy 1)

- Grade level meetings to discuss instructional strategies. Current focus is assessment (performance tasks).
- Weekly MTSS meeting held to discuss student SEL skills and needs with school support staff. Members discuss current and new referrals to determine/evaluate interventions for students. (CIWP Strategy 2)
